St. Mary Parish School will be providing parent access to PowerSchool to further promote educational excellence and enhance communication with parents. In response for the privilege of accessing PowerSchool, every parent is expected to act in a responsible, ethical and legal manner. PowerSchool will be available to every parent or guardian of a student enrolled at St. Mary Parish School. Users of PowerSchool are required to adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Parents will not share their passwords with anyone, including their children.
2. Parents will not attempt to harm or destroy data of their children or of another user, school, or district network or the Internet.
3. Parents will not use PowerSchool for any illegal activity, including violation of data privacy laws. Anyone found to be violating laws will be subject to civil and/or criminal prosecution.
4. Parents will not access data or any account owned by another parent.
5. Parents who identify a security problem with PowerSchool must notify St. Mary Parish School immediately, without demonstrating the problem to anyone else.
6. Parents who are identified as a security risk to the PowerSchool program or St. Mary computers or networks will be denied access to PowerSchool.
