Instead, they felt loved and cared about, thanks to your gifts to the Circle of Love.

Based on the success of last year's program, we are offering the same options this year.

On November 4-5, Christmas trees in the Gathering Space and at the Bell Tower will be decorated with envelopes for your selection. Here's how it will work:

- 1. If you prefer to give an actual gift** to an individual or ministry partner organization, select an envelope labeled "GIFT." The label will also indicate the age and gender of the recipient. Tucked inside the envelope will be gift suggestions and directions.
- 2. If you prefer to make a financial contribution** rather than purchase an actual gift, select an envelope labeled "FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION." The label will also indicate whether your contribution will support a specific ministry partner organization, or be directed to the Circle of Love's "Use my contribution where it's needed most" fund.
